



## **Transition Theater Tickets: Lesson Ideas**

### **Lesson #1**

Take a *Transition Theater Ticket* from the teacher as you enter the classroom. At the conclusion of the lesson, use the four transition stems to complete an exit ticket which summarizes the key points of the lesson. Return the *Transition Theater Ticket* with your completed exit ticket to the instructor.

### **Lesson #2**

Look at the transition stems on your *Transition Theater Ticket*. Walk around the room and find the other student, holding the same ticket. Once all partners are located, conduct a conversation with your partner, using the stems to answer a prompt on the board. (e.g. 1. What do you remember from yesterday's lesson? 2. Respond to one of the key points in the article or chapter you read for homework. )

### **Lesson #3**

Go to a learning station with three or four students and read the question posted there. Answer the question using the stems listed on one of the *Transition Theater Tickets*. Move to the next station and repeat the procedure.

### **Lesson #4**

Read the teacher-selected *Transition Theater Ticket* of the day. Respond to the subject-specific question using the transitions and/or transition phrases. Share responses.

### **Lesson #5**

At a critical point in a lesson, craft well-developed paragraphs using transitions or transition phrases from several *Transition Theater Tickets*. Use four or five transition stems in any order. Completed responses will be delivered as oral presentations or submitted as formative assessment pieces.
